SECTION A

I. MINUTES:

A. The September 17, 2019, Human Service Committee Meeting Minutes were electronically posted for review. Noting no corrections or changes, a recommendation was made to forward the Minutes to the Consent Agenda.

II. PERSONNEL:

B. The Director presented updates on the hiring status of a Social Worker position and Fiscal Supervisor position.

III. GENERAL:

- A. The CY 2020 Clinical Supervision Purchase of Service Agreement between Sherry Jose-Sobolik and this agency was presented for consideration. The proposed service rate for 2020 will remain at \$75.00/hour. The Director recommends the renewal of this purchase agreement. Upon conclusion of the presentation a recommendation was made to forward this item to the Consent Agenda.
- B. The CY 2020 MFIP/DWP Employment Services Joint Powers Agreement between this agency and the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development was presented for consideration. The proposed agreement calls for a cap of \$114,566.00 for provision of MFIP (Minnesota Family Investment Program) DWP (Diversionary Work Program) services to eligible participants. Upon conclusion of the presentation a recommendation was made to forward this item to the Consent Agenda.

- C. The Out-of-Home Cost Report through September 2019 was presented for review.
- D. Month's end cash balance for August 2019 stands at \$3,294,188.08.
- E. The Director presented an update on the all staff meeting held on October 8, 2019.

- I. No Social Service cases were presented for special case review.
- II. The Income Maintenance Supervisor presented the Emergency Assistance/Emergency General Assistance September 2019 report of activity. The Supervisor also reported the Income Maintenance open case count stands at 1,750.

- IV. A listing of bills presented for payment was reviewed. A recommendation for payment of the bills was forwarded to the Consent Agenda.
