OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS PENNINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY, APRIL 27TH, 2021, 5:00 P.M.

Pursuant to adjournment, the Pennington County Board of Commissioners met in the Pennington County Justice Center Board Room in Thief River Falls, MN, on Tuesday, April 27th, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. Members Present: Darryl Tveitbakk, Seth Nelson, Bruce Lawrence, and Neil Peterson. Members present via Zoom: David Sorenson (5:08 p.m.). Members Absent: None.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Peterson and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman Peterson asked if there were any amendments to the agenda. Hearing none, Commissioner Darryl motioned, seconded by Commissioner Tveitbakk, to approve the Board agenda as written. Motion carried.

Recognition of Citizens: None present.

Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve the County Board minutes of April 13th, 2021 as written. Motion carried.

Motioned by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Lawrence, to approve the Human Services warrants totaling \$93,808.94, the Auditor and Manual warrants for March totaling \$1,253,802.07, and the following Commissioner warrants; to include a payment to AVI Systems Inc. in the amount of \$4,455.55. Motion carried.

Per diems and meal reimbursements in the amount of \$62.83 were also approved.

Human Services Director Julie Sjostrand presented the consent agenda from the April 20th, 2021 Human Service Committee meeting. On a motion by Commissioner Tveitbakk and seconded by Commissioner Lawrence, the following recommendations of the Pennington County Human Service Committee for April 20th, 2021 (detailed minutes on record) are hereby adopted:

SECTION A

- I. To approve the March 16th, 2021 Human Service Committee meeting minutes.
- II. To approve the agency's personnel action as presented.
- III. A. To approve and reauthorize the Pennington County Pre-Petition Screening Team and the list of screeners as presented.

SECTION B

I. To approve payment of the Agency's bills.

Pennington County SWCD District Manager Peter Nelson presented a wetland permit application from the TRF Regional Airport. They are looking to purchase .1698 acres of wetland credit; there are currently 24 credits available at a cost of approximately \$18,000 per credit. Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve the sale of .1698 acres of wetland credit to the Thief River Falls Regional Airport. Motion carried.

Mr. Nelson stated that the Clearwater One Watershed One Plan needs to appoint an advisory committee member and Commissioner Tveitbakk has expressed interest. Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve the appointment of Commissioner Tveitbakk to the Clearwater One Watershed One Plan Advisory Committee. Motion carried.

Inter-County Nursing Director Kayla Jore was unable to attend the Board meeting.

County Engineer Mike Flaagan stated that the 5-year Road and Bridge Plan hearing was held today at 4:00 p.m. and is ready to be approved. Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to adopt the 5-year Road and Bridge Construction Plan as presented. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

Mr. Flaagan stated that proposals for design of the new Kratka Township bridge were sent out to three consultants and two were returned:

Houston Engineering \$35,857.01 Widseth, Smith & Nolting \$43,605.00

Mr. Flaagan recommended approval of the proposal submitted by Houston Engineering and noted that funding for the design will come from State Aid. Motioned by Commissioner Tveitbakk, seconded by Commissioner Lawrence, to approve the proposal by Houston Engineering in the amount of \$35,857.01 for design of the new Kratka Township bridge. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

Engineer Flaagan stated that a petition has been received to remove a parcel from the County Ditch #96 system and a public hearing must be scheduled. Motioned by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Lawrence, to schedule a Public Hearing in the County Board room on June 8th, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. regarding a petition to remove a parcel from the County Ditch #96 system. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

Mr. Flaagan stated that interviews were recently conducted for the position of Highway Equipment Operator and he recommended the hire of Joshua Iverson. Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve the hire of Josh Iverson as Highway Equipment Operator effective May 24th, 2021. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

County Sheriff Ray Kuznia was unable to attend the Board meeting due to work obligations.

Committee reports / Commissioner updates: None

County Auditor-Treasurer items: None

County Coordinator Items:

Kevin Erickson presented two proposals regarding the install of air conditioning in the server room of the Government Center. The room isn't sufficiently cooled by the building's HVAC system and additional cooling is needed to protect the servers and other electronic equipment in the room. Brodin Comfort Systems has provided a quote in the amount of \$8,500 for the purchase/install of a 3-ton air conditioning unit and related components, and Bergstrom Electric has provided a \$4,400 quote to install dedicated power for the unit and one 120v server outlet. The technology budget will be used to fund the project. Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve the quotes of Brodin Comfort Systems and Bergstrom Electric to furnish and install A/C and related power in the server room of the Government Center as stated above. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

Motioned by Commissioner Lawrence, seconded by Commissioner Nelson, to approve renewal of the GIS services and tech support contract with Pro-West & Associates effective 05/01/21 to 04/30/22 at a cost of \$3,185. Upon roll call vote: Nelson – Aye, Lawrence – Aye, Peterson – Aye, Sorenson – Aye, Tveitbakk – Aye. Motion carried.

Chairman Peterson opened discussion on the Enbridge tax appeal and the estimated refund portion for the affected counties. Pennington County's portion is estimated at \$2.4M with additional accrued interest estimated at \$480,000. AMC and MRC are working to get legislation so that the state will pay for the refunds as they overstated the values on the pipeline property.

Motioned by Commissioner Tveitbakk, seconded by Commissioner Lawrence, to adjourn the Board meeting to May 11th, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried.

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS PENNINGTON COUNTY 5-YEAR ROAD & BRIDGE PLAN HEARING TUESDAY, APRIL 27th, 2021, 4:00 P.M.

The Pennington County Board of Commissioners met in the Pennington County Justice Center Board Room in Thief River Falls, MN, on Tuesday, April 27th, 2021 at 4:00 P.M. Members Present: Darryl Tveitbakk, Bruce Lawrence, Seth Nelson and Neil Peterson. Members Present via Zoom: David Sorenson. Members absent: None.

Also present: County Engineer Mike Flaagan, Assistant County Engineer Alex Bladow, County Coordinator Kevin Erickson, and county constituent Luther Kaushagen. Present via Zoom: David Hill of the TRF Times, Grant Nelson of TRF Radio.

Chairman Peterson called the Hearing on the Five-Year Road & Bridge Plan to order at 4:00 p.m.

County Engineer Mike Flaagan then reviewed the Five-Year Road & Bridge Plan by explaining each project in the plan year by year.

The County Board discussed the combining of the highway shops near Goodridge. Commissioner Lawrence questioned the funding project 12 in 2024, to which Mr. Flaagan responded that LLP funds will be utilized as it is connected to a trunk highway.

Mr. Kaushagen asked about CR#65 east of the river, stating that that slope is failing. Mr. Flaagan responded that local funds would have to be used for that project and the related ditch is county-owned so that would also have to funded locally. It is possible that the slope repair work could be submitted to the One Watershed One Plan.

Mr. Kaushagen also questioned the possibility of an underpass at the 8th St. intersection in TRF. Mr. Flaagan stated that an underpass affects approximately one city block on each side of it and given the location of businesses near that crossing such a project would pose a large issue.

With no further comments on the 5-year Road and Bridge Plan the hearing was closed at 4:28 p.m.

LAW ENFORCEMENT LEASE AGREEMENT AND DISPATCH/ RECORDS AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE, to be effective the January 1st, 2021 by and between Pennington County, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor", and the City of Thief River Falls, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee", WITNESSETH:

- 1. PREMISES. Lessor hereby leases unto Lessee and Lessee hereby leases from Lessor the space the Lessee currently occupies or shares totaling 5,601.4 square feet of the Pennington County Law Enforcement Center.
- 2. POLICIES. Lessee agrees to abide by all statutes and ordinances, all of which are made a part hereof.
- 3. **TERM.** The term of this lease shall be for three (3) years, commencing on the 1st day of January, 2021 and terminating on the 31st day of December, 2023. All payments on this agreement shall be paid on a quarterly basis. This includes rent payments and dispatch and records payments. Lessor will bill Lessee within 30 days of the end of each quarter. Payments shall be due within 30 days of billing. After the end of the first year of this agreement both parties may review the terms of this agreement and mutually agreed upon revisions may be made.

4. RENT.

\$20.31 per square foot for 2021;

\$20.72 per square foot for 2022;

\$21.23 per square foot for 2023.

- **5. UTILITIES.** Lessor shall provide utilities, including, but not limited to, water, sewer, garbage, heat, air conditioning, electricity, telephone, and cable.
- 6. DISPATCH/ RECORDS. The Lessee shall be responsible for fifty percent (50%) of the dispatch and records salaries and benefits and shall be given notice as soon as the contract is finalized of those costs. The Lessee shall be notified of salary and benefit increases associated with finalized contracts or increases in size of staff.
- 7. LAW ENFORCEMENT TECHNOLOGY GROUP (LETG). The Lessee shall be responsible for one hundred percent (100%) of its portion for the LETG computer system annual maintenance fee. Lessee's portion of said fees during this lease are as follows:

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$7,476.76 for 2021;
$7,850.60 for 2022;
$8,243.13 for 2023.
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8. "INSIGHT MAPPING". The Lessee shall be responsible for a total of three (3) seats for the mobile mapping system between dispatch and the Police Department squad vehicles. Lessee's annual "Insight Mapping" fees during this lease are as follows:

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$289.78 for 2021;
$304.27 for 2022;
$319.48 for 2023.
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- REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE. Lessor shall be responsible for all repairs to the premises occupied by the Lessor and Lessee or spaces shared by the Lessor and Lessee.
- 10.POSSESSION. Lessee shall take possession of the premises and property in its present condition, without any liability or obligation on the part of the Lessor to make any alteration or replacements of any kind. Lessor warrants that at present, the premises, and all parts thereof, are in reasonable working order and fit for its particular purpose. Both parties during the term of this lease shall respect the rights of others using the premises prior to, during, or after its time of possession.
- **11.USE.** Lessee shall only use the premises for the following purposes: law enforcement purposes.

12.INSURANCE.

a. Lessee shall be responsible for insuring its own personal property within the premises and Lessor shall have no responsibility for any damage to, loss of, or theft of Lessee's personal property.

Lessor shall be responsible for insuring the structure.

b. Lessee shall, during the term of this lease, at its expense, maintain a policy or policies of public liability insurance with respect to the premises in which Lessee and Lessor shall be covered by being named as insured parties under reasonable limits of liability of not less than the amounts dictated by Minnesota Statute §466.04. The Lessee shall hold harmless the lessor for any injury or death caused by the Lessee to its employees or others by actions of the Lessee or its employees.

Lessor shall, during the term of this lease, at its expense, maintain a policy or policies of public liability insurance with respect to the premises in which Lessor and Lessee shall be covered by being named as insured parties under reasonable limits of liability of not less than the amounts dictated by Minnesota Statute §466.04. The Lessor shall hold harmless the Lessee for any injury or death caused by the Lessor to its employees or others by actions of the Lessor or its employees.

- c. Lessee shall not do anything in or about the premises which will in any way impair or invalidate the obligation of the insurer under the above policy or policies of insurance.
- d. The insurance which Lessee is required to maintain shall be insured by an insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Minnesota and acceptable to Lessor. The insurance policy shall provide for not less than ten (10) days written notice to the Lessor before cancellation, non-renewal, termination or change in coverage, and Lessee shall deliver a duplicate original or certificate of such insurance policy or policies.
- e. Lessee hereby waives, holds harmless, releases any claims, liabilities, and causes of action against Lessor, its agents and employees, for loss or damage to, or destruction of, any of the personal property whether that of Lessee or others in, upon, or about the premises resulting from fire, explosion, or other perils, whether included or not included in standard extended coverage insurance.

Lessor hereby waives, holds harmless, releases any claims, liabilities, and causes of action against Lessee, its agents and employees, for loss or damage to, or destruction of, any of the personal property whether that of Lessor or others in, upon, or about the premises resulting from fire, explosion, or other perils, whether included or not included in standard extended coverage insurance.

- 13. DEFAULT. Should Lessee be in default in the payment of rent or in the performance of any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this Lease, Lessor shall give notice of the specific items of default to Lessee, and should Lessee fail to cure such default within 30 days after the date of said notice, then Lessor may declare this Lease forfeited and reenter the premises and take possession thereof and remove Lessee and all of Lessee's property. Should Lessee be diligently pursuing the correction of the default, but should such correction reasonably take more than 30 days, Lessee shall have such additional time as may be needed should Lessee pursue the matter diligently.
- **14. TERMINATION OF LEASE.** This lease shall terminate on December 31, 2023. However, upon agreement of the parties, either party may terminate this lease with 180 days written notice to the other party.

15.HOLD HARMLESS. Lessee shall hold harmless Lessor from any liability for damages to any person or property in or upon the premises, which damages result from the actions or inactions of Lessee, its employees and agents, including the person and property of Lessee and its employees and all persons in the premises at their invitation or sufferance, and from all damages resulting from Lessee's failure to perform the covenants of this Lease.

Lessor shall hold harmless Lessee from any liability for damages to any person or property in or upon the premises, which damages result from the actions or inactions of Lessor, its employees and agents, including the person and property of Lessor and its employees and all persons in the premises at their invitation or sufferance, and from all damages resulting from Lessor's failure to perform the covenants of this Lease.

- 16. ASSIGNMENT OF SUBLETTING. There shall be no subletting of any portion of the premises by the Lessee without permission of the Pennington County Board.
- 17. **RELATIONSHIP.** The Lease does not create the relationship of principal and agent or of partnership or of joint venture of on any association between Lessor and ,Lessee. The sole relationship between the parties hereto being that of Lessor and Lessee.
- 18. ENTIRE AGREEMENT INVALIDITY. This Agreement sets forth the entire arrangement between the parties and there are no representations or warranties except as expressly set forth herein. No amendment or modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the parties hereto. Should any clause or provision of this Agreement become invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not result in the invalidity or unenforceability of any other clause or provision of this Agreement.
- 19. ALTERATIONS. Lessee shall not make any alterations or additions to the premises without giving the Lessor twenty (20) days written notice of all alterations or additions intended. Should Lessor not object by written notice within the allowed time, Lessee shall be free to make said alterations and additions at Lessee's own cost. All alterations or additions shall belong to Lessor without compensation at the termination of this Lease. However, Lessor, at its option, may require Lessee to remove any or all such alterations or additions and to return the premises to its prior condition. Lessee shall not allow any liens or other encumbrances to attach to the premises as a result of said alterations or additions.
- 20.DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION. If the premises or any part thereof shall be partially destroyed by fire, storm, earthquake, or other casualty, the premises shall be promptly repaired by Lessor and there shall be an abatement of rent corresponding with the time during which, and the extent of which, the premises may have been tenantable. But, if the premises shall be damaged to the extent that Lessor shall decide not to rebuild or repair, the term of this Lease shall end and the rent shall be pro-rated to the time of the damage. In any case, should the required repairs be anticipated to take more than 30 days, Lessee shall have the right to immediately terminate this Lease and the rent

shall be prorated to the time of damage. Should Lessor be diligently pursuing the correction of the destruction, but should such correction reasonably take more than 30 days, Lessor shall have such additional time as may be needed should Lessee pursue the matter diligently.

- 21. HOLDING OVER. In the event Lessee remains in possession, of the premises after the expiration of this Lease and without the execution of a new Lease, it shall be deemed to be occupying the premises as a Lessee from month to month, subject to all the conditions, provisions, and obligations of this Lease.
- **22. NOTICES.** All notices and other communications required herein shall be in writing, mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of each party, to be effective on date of mailing.
